For all other resource types the Title field (along with rubric and valet pids) in the Portal appears with the remainder of the metadata record beneath the Document details.
Description/Abstract (free text field)	Yes  (maps to the label "Description" -- which is the same label as the Additional Notes data.)
Year (free text field)	Yes  (maps to the label "Date")

<b>Valet metadata element</b>	<b>Maps to Access Portal?</b>
Language (drop down box)	Yes  (but no entry if the language is English)
Keywords  (free text field)	Yes  But a blank Dublin Core subject field is also regularly created obligating one to edit the DC file in the Manager each time to remove the blank entry from the Access Portal.  (maps to the label "Subjects" -- which is the same label as the RFCD codes)
Subjects (RFCD codes)	Yes  (maps to the label "Subjects" -- which is the same label as the keywords)

### Deposit Form Heading: About the Creator

Creator (Original) Last name, First name	Yes
Creator (Original) Affiliation	Yes -- but:  Incorrectly if there are multiple authors
Creator (1) Last name, First name	Yes
Creator (1) Affiliation	Incorrectly  (The raw data maps but in the case of multiple authors the different affiliations will rarely match the correct authors; sometimes the different affiliations will appear in a bundle and the authors in another bundle so no match is indicated.)
